### A Library for the future

Whitehorse have been engaged to assist the Northern Territory Library Service to conduct an EDMS readiness review



The Department of Health and Community Services (DHCS) intends to implement Best Practice records management utilizing TRIM's full Electronic Document Management capabilities.

The project includes:

- A DHCS records environment stocktake
- Internal TRIM locations assessment
- Record types status review Disposal schedules
- Security matrix
- Forms review, and a
- Business Classification Scheme

The project commences this month, and will be led by Whitehorse director Ana Govan.

#### Northern Territory Library

The Northern Territory Library is located in Parliament House, in the State Square complex in the heart of Darwin City.

The Library is the Northern Territory's major reference and research Library, responsible for collecting, preserving and providing access to the Territory's documentary heritage and connecting people to the world of information.

Northern Territory Library is the Territory's equivalent of a State Library.

### Helping to incubate the Incubator

#### New Media and IT Business Incubator for Northern Melbourne

A former Police Station in Northcote, in Darebin, north of the Melbourne CBD, is the focus of a proposal to establish a New Media and IT Business Incubator on the site. A draft Business Plan for the Business Incubator has been prepared, confirming its economic viability.

#### The aim is to graduate 5 "New Media and IT" businesses a year

Darebin Council, the Darebin Enterprise Centre (DECL), and the Pearcey Foundation are cooperating on the project, with the Pearcey Foundation agree to relocate its HQ to the building, and also provide facilities, equipment, and promotional and administrative support for the Incubator, in cooperation with the established business development programmes of DECL.

The State and Federal members of Parliament for the area, Fiona Richardson and Martin Ferguson, strongly support this proposal.

The proposal is also strongly supported by the Victorian Branch of the Australian Computer Society and by other senior Victorian IT figures

DECL is a small Business Incubator established with strong local support as a non-profit company in 1998. It has been self-sustaining since 1999

The Pearcey Foundation Inc is a not-for-profit association dedicated to promoting and recognising Australian ICT talent and achievement, and has been strongly supported by the Government and the ICT Industry since its formation in 1998.

Whitehorse Director, and Pearcey Foundation National Chairman, Ian Dennis, is assisting Darebin council and DECL with the business case, and with negotiations with the Victorian Government to help to achieve this worthwhile outcome.
