Whitehorse history

Whitehorse Information Systems was formed in 1983, with Ian Dennis as Managing Director. The company developed software products for export. Whitehorse staff were awarded one of the first Australian Design Awards for software in 1987.

After merging with Scientia to form Scientia-Whitehorse Ltd, we continued with the development of manufacturing and scheduling systems. Consulting projects came under the Software and Services Industry Federation (SSIFA). With the merger of SSIFA and the Australian Information Industries Association completed, the remaining export facilitation consulting services of SSIFA were consolidated into Whitehorse Strategic Group Ltd.

From 1989 to 1992 Ian Dennis worked with Ernst Young on the negotiation with the European Esprit project Eureka Software Factory for the Federal Government and the development of export strategies for Austrade for IT and software services.

From 1993 to 1995 we assisted Duesburys/Deloitte to improve consulting and other service marketing. A major position in outsourcing advisory services was achieved, with clients including the Department of Defence, Department of Prime Minister & Cabinet, and the Victorian Department of Justice.

In 1995 we started to develop the strategy that later became called Ballarat IT 2010. This project brought David Goble into the Whitehorse family. David had previously served as management consulting Partner with Deloitte Touche Tohmatsu and Duesburys, with over twenty years experience in management consulting, information and telecommunications and education. He spent over five years with Telecom Australia working on software systems for telephony and data networks, and was also involved in the design and building of experimental communication systems within the Telecom Research Laboratories, and also spent nearly ten years at Chisholm Institute and Monash University as an academic and consultant, culminating in his appointment in 1981 as executive director of the Pearcey Centre.
